Dear Colleague,

We are pleased to announce that Heidelberg University has started a series of international summer and winter schools for doctoral students in various academic fields. The objectives of this project are to strengthen academic collaboration between Asia, Europe and Latin America and to foster networks of young researchers from these regions. The project is funded by Santander Universidades. All costs (attendance fee, travel and accommodation) for doctoral students who have been awarded a scholarship will be covered by this programme.

The project consists of two programme lines:

**“TOP Programme“ Europe – Latin America:**

One summer/winter school per year at the Internationales Wissenschaftsforum Heidelberg or at the Heidelberg Center Latin America in Santiago de Chile.

**“ELITE Programme“ Asia – Europe – Latin America:**

Up to two summer/winter schools per year, alternately at the Internationales Wissenschaftsforum Heidelberg, the Heidelberg Center Latin America, the Heidelberg Center South Asia in New Delhi, and a university in Japan.

The second winter school of the ELITE Programme – **“What is Caesar’s, what is God’s? – A transcultural Perspective on the Legitimation of the political and religious Spheres”** – will take place from March 9 to 18, 2015, at Kyoto University, Japan, which is at the same time our scientific coordination partner for this winter school.

Participants could be doctoral students in the field of humanities, for instance religious studies, history, anthropology, theology, philosophy, area studies or asian studies.

Twenty outstanding doctoral students from selected universities in Asia, Europe and Latin America will be invited to participate in the winter school.

We would like to invite Aristotle University of Thessaloniki to participate in this programme and would appreciate if you could inform the corresponding academic units of your university about this opportunity. Doctoral supervisors can nominate their students for the winter school scholarship. Nominations should be sent to Heidelberg University by **May 31, 2014** – please see the documents attached.


If we receive more nominations than places available, a scientific committee will decide about the scholarships awarded. We will be glad to inform you about the results after the selection procedure.
